### GOD'S WORD

#### 2 Tim 3:16-17

**All scripture is God breathed** (given by inspiration of God), and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

#### Matt 5:18

**For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law**, till all be fulfilled. Jot – smallest letter  
Tittle - smallest stroke of a pen

#### Ps 138:2

I will worship toward thy holy temple, And give thanks unto thy name for thy loving kindness and for thy truth: **For thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.**

#### John 10:35-36

If he called them 'gods,' to whom the word of God came-- **and the Scripture cannot be broken--**

what about the one whom the Father set apart as his very own and sent into the world? Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, 'I am God's Son'?

#### Rom 3:1-2

What advantage, then, is there in being a Jew, or what value is there in circumcision?

Much in every way! First of all, they have been entrusted with **the very words of God.**

#### Heb 4:12

**For the word of God is alive and powerful**, and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing even to the dividing of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and quick to discern the thoughts and intents of the heart.

If you are convinced that you are a guide for the blind, a light for those who are in the dark, an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of infants, **because you have in the law the embodiment of knowledge and truth--**

2 Pet 1:16-21

- 16 We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.
- 17 For he received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to him from the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."
- 18 We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with him on the sacred mountain.
- 19 **But we have a more sure word of prophecy**, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.
- 20 **Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.**
- 21 For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

1 Cor 2:11. . . no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.

1 Cor 1:20-21
