Fallacy 12: The priority of the church is the growth of the members.

Truth: The love of the pastor for the members is manifested by his diligence in feeding, tending and caring for the members by teaching Bible doctrine daily, in season, or out of season (John 21:15-17, 2 Tim. 2:13-16).

Argument: The primary job of the pastor is to study the Word of God in isagogics, categorical and exegetical approach, with keen attention to its accuracy. His job is to communicate Bible doctrine and not to make the world a better place to live. The ministry of the pastor is to make known the plan, the will, and the purpose of God and not to clean the devil's world. Ironically, most "servants of God" are busy serving cosmos diabolicus of Satan.
