

## *Blessing in Time*

The blessings in time refer to the sixth imputation for Church Age believers who have reached spiritual maturity. The seventh imputation is the blessings of eternity. The sixth and seventh imputations of time and eternity respectively from the justice of God are beyond blessing that we have known about (John 10:10).

Every human being is the beneficiary at birth of the two imputations namely: the soul life to biological life and Adam's original sin to old sin nature. When a person believes in Christ, he personally appropriates three more imputations namely: his personal sin imputed to Christ on the cross for judgment, God's perfect righteousness imputed on him and God's eternal life.

Every believer who has ever lived has been benefited by all five of these decisions of divine justice. But just as salvation carries the plan of God a stage human life and spiritual death, there is yet a stage beyond salvation. This is the realm of maximum blessing from the justice of God. For the unbeliever it is just a potential not yet a reality. In the same manner, the blessings of time are merely a potential for the immature believer.

As humans, man is alive forever. As a believer, you are saved forever. But you may or may not see the blessings of time and eternity. The blessings of time and eternity are exclusive for the spiritually mature believers. The only requirement and prerequisite is spiritual maturity.

The blessings of time occur when the justice of God pours blessings through His grace pipeline to the righteousness of God in the spiritually mature believer residing and functioning in the divine dynasphere. It is given only to the believer who, through Bible doctrine, possesses capacity for blessings. This is real imputation because there is an affinity between divine blessings and imputed divine righteousness.

Two judicial imputations were required before there could be any such real imputation of blessing in time. By believing in Christ, we as it were, exchanged our sins for God's perfect righteousness so that we actually possess part of the integrity of God.

Only when we have His righteousness is there a home in us into which God can pour His blessings when we reach spiritual maturity.

Righteousness in God demands His perfect righteousness in us. What God's righteousness accepts His justice blesses. This axiom stands unbroken even when God blesses us. The justice of God can bless only the indwelling righteousness of God imputed at the moment of salvation.

God is consistent and faithful; He prospers us only when, in doing so, He avoids all possibility of compromise to His perfect character. He blesses through His grace.

The blessings in time are the "much more" of Romans chapter 8. It is the "abundant life" of John 10:10 and the "greater grace" of James 4:6 reserved especially for the mature believers. Spiritual maturity is measured by the maximum Bible Doctrine in the souls of believers.

Spiritual maturity is the beginning of the normal Christian life and the opening of the "windows" of heaven for pouring amazing blessings that comes from the justice of God. Blessings in time are different from logistical blessings for sustaining the Church Age believers in the cosmos diabolicus but designed for glorifying Christ.

The blessings of time are categorized into six major groups:

- Spiritual blessings
- Temporal blessings
- Blessings by association
- Historical blessings
- Undeserved suffering blessings
- Dying grace blessing

All the spiritual blessings are distributed to every spiritually mature believer. The spiritual blessings includes the resident and functional epignosis, maximum perception and assimilation of Bible doctrine, occupation with Christ, inner and complete happiness, relaxed-mental attitude, genuine peace, fortified soul, in one word, spiritual maturity.

Spiritual maturity is the greatest and the most important blessings in time that open all other doors of blessings.

Temporal blessings in time are divided into promotion and prosperity (Eph. 3:19-21). Promotion is a divinely imputed blessing in forms of advancement but not beyond our individual capabilities. God will promote the spiritually mature believer within his capacity and divinely given abilities.

God will move up the believer without depending on politics, without spending your time cultivating all the people that could influence your climb to a higher position. During the lifetime of the believers, God allows experiences that contribute to their capacity and abilities. God cannot promote the saints without abilities and capacity to handle the divinely given promotion.

Prosperity is a blessing that is imputed into the many spheres of life. Not everyone will be prosperous in the same areas. There are nine categories of prosperity that are imputed to believers at the point of spiritual maturity.

- Social prosperity
- Sexual prosperity
- Professional prosperity
- Mental prosperity
- Cultural prosperity
- Establishment prosperity
- Leadership prosperity
- Physical prosperity

This imputed prosperity is different from earned prosperity in the cosmic system. For example, social prosperity means having true friends who will be friends forever. Friendship is part of logistical provisions but with richer capacity for life and love that comes from spiritual maturity, social prosperity is even more wonderful and refreshing.

Sexual prosperity is God's given ability for sexual pleasure and procreation. Technical prosperity is God's given ability to excel in science, technology, or engineering. Professional prosperity is the ability given to believers in the professional fields such as law, teaching, medicine, military and others.

Mental prosperity is imputed enhanced ability to think, to exercise reason, widening frame of reference and common sense.

Mental prosperity also increases the believer's IQ, increases perceptiveness, and provides interest in many subjects that were previously unappealing to him. The God's given Establishment prosperity includes the protection of freedom, privacy and property to include protection from crime and reprisal.

Leadership prosperity is imputed to those who has ability to lead, to take responsibility and to assume authority without going out of God's will and purpose to seek them. God will promote the prepared, able and capable believer at the right time. Physical prosperity is good health imputed to mature believer after a lengthened poor health or sickness.

Blessing by association refers to blessing that overflows to those in the periphery of the spiritually mature believer. Blessings overflow to family, church, friends and associates in the work place. Historical impact is imputed blessings to spiritually mature believers that which extend to his community, province and nation. A nation is protected, preserved and provided because of a pivot of spiritual mature believers (Ps. 33:18-22, Isaiah 36:5-37:15).

Undeserved sufferings are exclusively given to spiritually mature believers that aim to promote and accelerate their advancement to super grace status. The undeserved sufferings are intensified and magnified testing where the believers are expected to utilize their God's given problem-solving devices and spiritual resources. Dying grace is the final blessing the mature believer will receive on earth.

From the very moment the believer breaks the maturity barrier, he will start to live under the super grace status receiving the blessing in time that glorifies God. These blessings are designed to glorify God while the believers are on earth. Majority of Church Age believers will never experience these tremendous blessings because of carnality and immaturity.

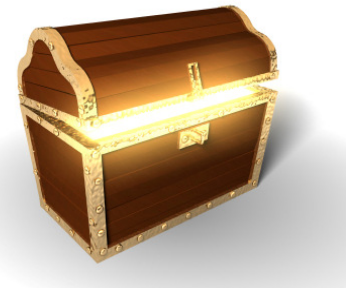
God the Father has elected every church age believer in eternity past to privilege in order to bless them with an eternal inheritance. A prominent doctrine of the New Testament concerns the Doctrine of rewards and the Judgment Seat of Christ.

Spiritual rewards become one of the great motivations of the spiritual's life or should. But we need to understand the nature of these rewards in order to understand the nature of the motivation. The Bible clearly promises us rewards. Spiritual rewards become one of the great motivations of the Christian's life.

Every church age believer has the opportunity to receive his eternal inheritance if he fulfills the condition of being faithful till death or the rapture whichever comes first and thus executes the Father's will for his life. Both the Old and New Testament's speak of an inheritance, which could be forfeited due to unfaithfulness.

The inheritances in the Bible are:

- Related to God's plan for the believer after salvation
- Added blessings to the Saved ( Rewards on top of salvation)
- Possession Is meritorious ownership of the kingdom (Millennium and eternal state)
- Conditioned on faithful obedience to the will of God
- Can be forfeited through habitual disobedience to the will of God.
